

Let's go fly a kite

Here is everything you will need to make a kite; Plastic bag, scissors, string, tape. Also either three skewer sticks, bamboo sticks or straws.



Lay your plastic bag out onto the side, then cut the sides and handles off. Using a ruler or free hand draw a diamond onto the plastic bag.



Using your skewer sticks, straws or bamboo sticks create a cross. To do this place the stick into the frame of your kite, to make sure you cut the two sticks to the correct size for your kite.



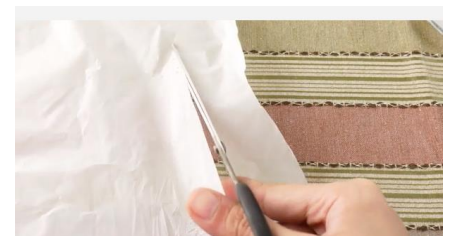
Time to secure the two sticks together. Using string continually wrap the string around the sticks. Once you feel like the sticks are secure, tie a knot.



Cut out your kite frame, then using tape secure the sticks to the plastic bag.



Using a small pin or scissors, create two small holes either side of the sticks, closest to where the two sticks cross. Next secure the sticks to your kite by threading through string between both holes, then tying the string into a knot.



It is time to create the kite's tail. Grab another plastic bag, using scissors cut four rectangles then tie them together.



Next tie the tail near the bottom of the bamboo sticks.



The kite needs a handle. To create the handle, cut in half another stick, then wrap around string in the middle.



Secure the handle to the kite by tying string to the sticks.



Now all the steps have been completed, it is time to go outdoors and fly the kite.
